## PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

Unless exempt for religious reasons all employees shall provide a certificate of good health before being employed in accordance with section 118.25(2)(a)(b)(c) and 143.17(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes. A physical examination should include a tuberculin test as prescribed by law.

1) A tuberculin test or chest x-ray, and a physical exam will be required at least every five years. Employees who react to the tuberculin test are required to have chest x-rays annually before school starts.

2) The cost of <u>that part of physical examination</u> required by law will be paid by the employee upon receipt of the physical certificate from the examining physician.

3) If an employee is suspected to have a medical condition that could impair his/her ability to perform his/her job or could present a potentially unsafe condition for students or other staff, the employee may be required to undergo medical or psychological testing to ensure a safe condition exists.
