POLICY 683

Capital Asset Management

The business office shall keep an accurate record of capital assets with a cost of \$5,000 or above and will also include items having a life value warranting inventory under a capital asset inventory. The items with a value of less than \$5,000 have been considered items to be lumped by year or have a life value that should be included in a capital asset inventory. The general listing of capital assets to be included are as indicated below and the estimated useful life in years of asset class is indicated.
