

SCHOOL BOARD ELECTION

School Board members are elected at the general spring election following the declaration of candidacy and success in the spring primary election should one prove necessary. All procedures and methods of election are followed as outlined in the state statutes. The winner of the election is determined by a Board of Canvassers consisting of the School District Clerk and two other citizens appointed by him/her, who canvass the ballots from the various municipalities within 24 hours following the spring election. School Board members thus elected shall take office provided they take and file the official oath of office as prescribed by law.

School Board members are elected to three-year terms of office. In the spring of 2013, two members will be elected. In the spring of 2014, two members will be elected. In the spring of 2015, one member will be elected.

The same number of members shall be elected annually in the same sequence. School Board member's term of office begins on the first regularly scheduled Board meeting following the canvassing of the votes, *but no later than the fourth Monday in April.*
