

## SCHOOL ATTORNEY

The School Board recognizes that the increasing complexity of the school district operation frequently requires a procurement of professional legal services.

The school attorney services will be the firm of Weld, Riley, S.C. in Eau Claire.

The District Administrator and/or Board President shall have the authority to confer with the school attorney for legal advice on such matters as he/she deems advisable in order to protect the interest of the school district, Board or staff or when directed to do so by official Board action.

Other school administrators shall not be authorized to confer with the school attorney unless approved or directed to do so by the District Administrator or by official Board action.

Individual Board members may be authorized to confer with the school attorney by official Board action or by the approval of the Board president.

Legal counsel shall be appointed for a term not to exceed three years, subject to an annual review.
