BOARD COMMITTEES

The Board shall have no standing committees. The Board may delegate portions of its exploratory, fact-finding, and preliminary work to temporary **or ad-hoc** committees. These are advisory, however, and have no power to take action whatsoever, or to commit the Board or district to any course of action, except as specifically directed by the Board.

It shall be the duty of the President of the Board to appoint all committees, except when the Board itself may decide otherwise. The first person named to any committee shall be considered the chairperson.

Board members participating on these designated committees or representing the District may receive the per diem amount as set forth in board policy #164. However, these per diem amounts can be waived, in advance, by a majority of the board present.
