

CLOSED CAMPUS WAIVER

School District of Independence

- I. Students taking non-traditional classes off-campus must sign-out and sign-in at the main office.
- II. Students who have a schedule where classes begin 8:30 am or later do not need to report to school until their class is scheduled to begin. If students are in the building they should be in either their assigned Advisory Classroom, Library, or Cafetorium.
- III. Students who have schedules where classes end at 2:13 or earlier are allowed to leave school after their classes are completed. If they have a class that ends at 2:14 or later, they will be assigned to Cafetorium Study and IEB.
- IV. Juniors and seniors may apply to be excused from IEB by the high school principal. The following conditions must be met.
 - 1) The student is not scheduled into an academic intervention.
 - 2) The student achieved a 3.0 (on a 4 point scale) or better GPA during their last semester of attendance.
 - 3) Regularly attend their classes (90% or better)
 - 4) Have no trancies in the most recent quarter.
 - 5) Have parental permission.
 - 6) Be approved by the high school principal.
- V. Students taking non-traditional classes on-campus and have a break in their schedule of 75 minutes or more between face-to-face classes, may also leave campus during this break if they follow the following procedures and there is a parent consent form on file.
 - 1) Sign out at the office at least 30 minutes before the next scheduled class.
 - 2) Sign in at the office upon return and be in class before the scheduled start time.
 - 3) They must also meet the standards set in IV above.

The privilege of leaving campus under the above conditions may be terminated if any of the following occur.

- 1) Not meet the criteria set in IV above.
 - 2) The parent and/or principal deem it is in the best interest of the student that they remain at school during the break because of a decline in academic performance. Failing grades, missing assignments, or poor quality work are some, but not all reasons the student may be required to stay at school.
 - 3) The student does not follow the require sign-in and sign-out procedures.
- VI If students have a non-traditional class that ends before our semester end date they may, with parent consent, not report to school during that class time. (use Non Traditional Class End parent consent form)

Acknowledgement. For cases IV, V, VI, a student and parent signature is required to acknowledge that the conditions and consequences are understood regarding the Closed Campus Waiver..
